Conference on lab animals in biomedical research at IISER

Pune: The ninth international conference of LASA India — LASACON 2019 — on “Laboratory Animals in Biomedical Research — The Way Forward” would be held on November 22 and 23 at the Indian Institute of Science Education and Research (IISER). The IISER, National Centre for Cell Science (NCCS) and Laboratory Animal Scientists’ Association (LASA), India, would jointly organized it.

There would be two pre-conference workshops on November 21 — “Establishing Indian College of Laboratory Animal Medicine (ICLAM): A Speciality Program of LASA India” with help from the International Association of Colleges of Laboratory Animal Medicine (IACLAM) and “Critical Factors Affecting Cage Processing and Lab Animal Hygiene” with help from Tecniplast, Italy.

“The laboratory animal science in India is growing rapidly, both in quality and quantity. The LASACON 2019 will bring together the leading academic scientists, veterinarians, researchers and scholars associated with laboratory animals from around the world. Our goal is to foster an open and unconventional discussion to develop novel ideas and approaches to face the current challenges of the laboratory animal science in biomedical research,” a notification of IISER stated.
