Nuclear scientist Kakodkar to be honoured

Ahmedabad: Renowned nuclear scientist and mechanical engineer Anil Kakodkar will be honoured at the Physical Research Laboratory (PRL) in Ahmedabad on November 11 for his contribution to the development of indigenous nuclear reactor technology and formulation of policy framework in strategic areas.
